

PRINCE GEORGE'S CHAPEL CEMETERY COMMITTEE

MAY 4, 2024, AT 9:00 AM

DAGSBORO TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order by President Janice Kolbeck at 9:00a.m. In attendance were Patti Adams, Gayle Chandler, Cindi Brought, Melody Chandler, Norwood Truitt, and Paulette Hickman.

A motion was made by Melody and seconded by Paulette to approve the May 4, 2024, agenda. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Paulette and seconded by Norwood to approve the minutes of November 21, 2023. All were in favor.

Cindi discussed the treasurer's report. Several CD's were renewed for nine months. The dues were paid for membership in the Delaware Cemetery Board. A motion was made by Gayle and seconded by Patti to approve the treasurer's report. All were in favor.

Gayle reported that Kim Frey inquired about potential gravesites for sale in the cemetery; Gayle referred her to Cindi. Cindi said there are a few; she refers individuals wanting gravesites to people who are willing to sell their plots.

There are meetings of the Delaware Cemetery Board scheduled in August and October 2024.

There was a discussion about the lack of a chapel representative to this committee. The friends of the chapel have no president at present. Norwood volunteered as the chapel representative to our committee. It was decided that a vote approving him could be held in a separate cemetery officers' meeting.

Gray's Creative Concepts is cutting the cemetery grass. Some of the decorations were destroyed and/or blown away after being cut up by the mowers. The cemetery was cleaned up afterwards by Joe Quinn. It was suggested that Xmas decorations should be removed now and that Easter decorations be removed by Memorial Day. Gayle will put the information on the town's Facebook and town's website. It was also suggested that it be

announced at local churches. The town has the responsibility for removing old decorations. A VFW plaque at the base of the US flag is tarnished; it was decided that Melody Chandler should contact VFW 7234 for permission to clean it using the same materials (D2) as are being used at Arlington National Cemetery. The Frank Woodall grave needs dirt to make it level; Cindi will contact the undertaker who handled the funeral. There is another grave in the same situation, but it's not as bad.

A motion was made by Gayle and seconded by Patti to nominate Carol Thompson for the position of town representative. All were in favor.

A motion was made by Paulette and seconded by Norwood to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 9:27a.m.
